

China, China Scholars and China Scholarship: The Oral History of China Studies in Asian Communities

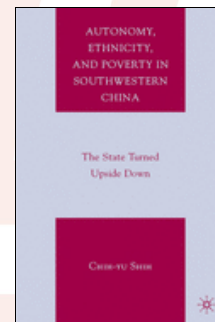

Abstract

Professor Shih will brief the origin, evolution and execution of the multi-year, multi-country project of China experts in Korea, Japan, Singapore, Vietnam, India, Taiwan, Russia, Australia and Hong Kong (by the order of the time when the project was first initiated in the community) as well as overseas Sino-phone experts on China. He will report preliminary results, introduce the upcoming agenda and invite the support and participation of colleagues in Leiden.



Chih-yu Shih teaches political psychology, cultural studies and China studies in the capacity of University Chair Professor in the Department of Political Science at National Taiwan University. He is additionally the author of many reviewed books including *Autonomy, Ethnicity and Poverty in Southwestern China: The State Turned Upside Down* (2007), *Navigating Sovereignty: World Politics Lost in China* (2003), *Collective Democracy: Political and Legal Reform in China* (1999), *State and Society in China's Political Economy* (1995), *The Spirit of Chinese Foreign Policy: A Psychocultural View* (1990), and many others, Editor Routledge's *Asian Ethnicity* and an editorial board member of a few international and domestic political science as well as China studies journals. He is MPP of Harvard University and Ph.D of University of Denver.
